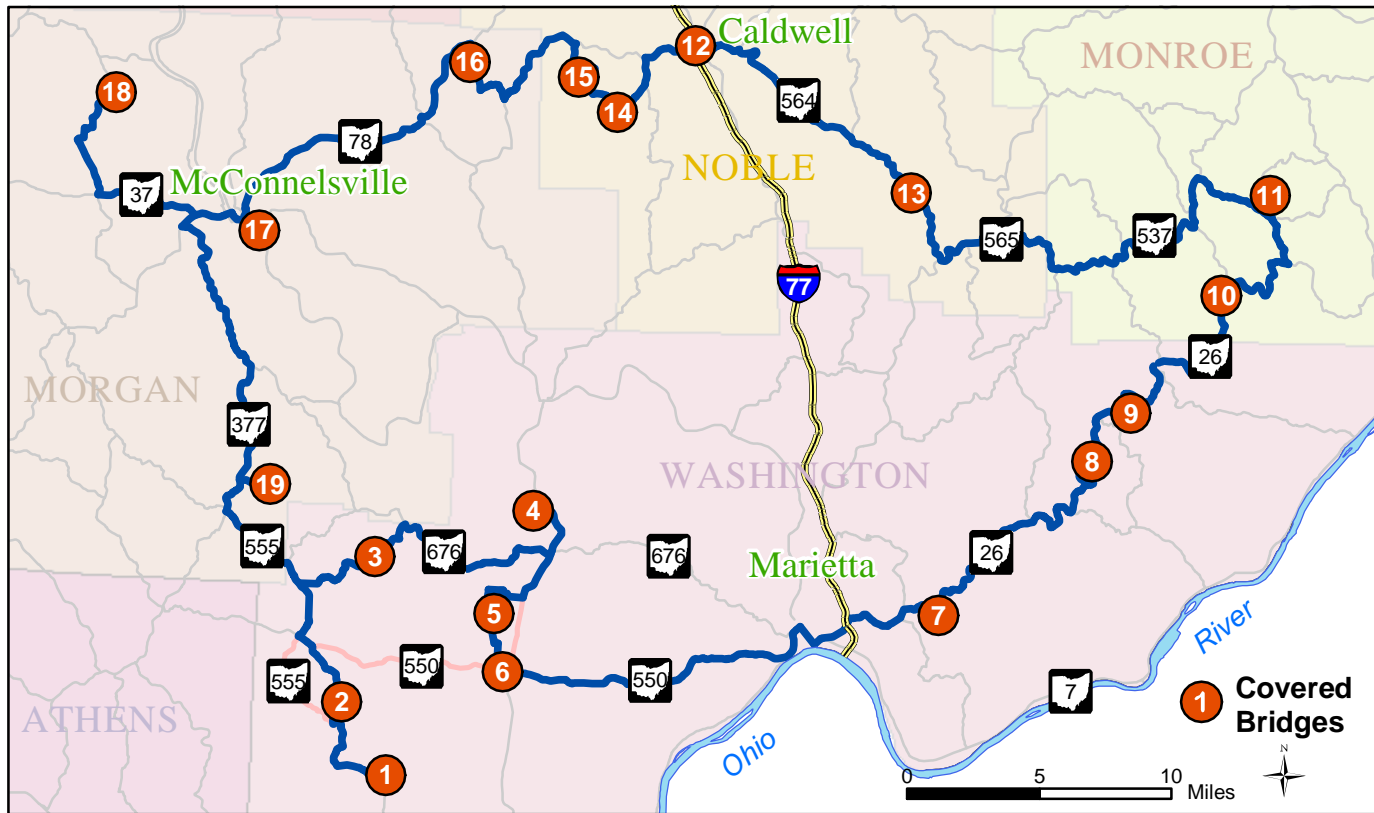


Southeastern Ohio Covered Bridges Tour

Root Bridge

County Rd 6 over West Branch Little Hocking River, Decatur Twp Section 11/17

Built: 1888.

Length 65'

Henry Bridge

Township Rd. 61 over W. Branch little Hocking River, Fairfield Twp Section 20

Built: 1894

Length 45'

3

Shinn Bridge

Township Rd 447 over W. Branch Wolf Creek, Palmer Twp Section 14

Built: 1886

Length 98'

4

Harra Bridge

Township Rd. 172 off 339, north of Watertown.

Built: 1871

Length 95'

5

Bell Bridge

Located northwest of Barlow on TR39 over Southwest Fork Wolf Creek, Barlow Twp Section 30

Built: 1888

Length 63'

6

Mill Branch Bridge

Located at Barlow on fairgrounds, Barlow Twp Section 30

Built: 1832

Length 59'

7

Hills Hildreth Bridge

County Rd. 333 over little Muskingum River, Newport Twp Section 36

Built: 1878

Length 122'

8

Hune Bridge

TR34 over Little Muskingum River, Lawrence Twp Section 6

Built: 1879

Length 128'

9

Rinard Bridge

CR406 over Little Muskingum River, Ludlow Twp Section 26

Built: 1879

Length 128'

10

Knowlton Bridge

TR 384 in Covered Bridge Park over Little Muskingum River, Washington Twp Section 6

Built: 1887

Length 192'

11

Foraker Bridge

Plainview Rd (CR40) over Little Muskingum River, Perry Twp Section 28

Built: 1886

Length 92'

12

Huffman Bridge

1.5 mi. S of Middleburg off SR 564 (destroyed in flood – 1998)

Built: 1914

Length 50'

13

Park Hill/Rich Valley Bridge

Two Noble County covered bridges were combined to make the Caldwell Fairgrounds Bridge. When the Rich Valley bridge and the Park Hill bridge were torn down in 1970, parts of both were used for the Caldwell Fairgrounds Bridge. Located on the Fairgrounds directly off Interstate 77.

Parrish Bridge

County Rd 8 over Olive Green Creek, Sharon Twp Section 24

Built: 1914

Length 81'

15 Manchester Bridge

Township Rd 3 over Olive Green Creek, Sharon Twp Section 14
Built: 1915
Length 49'

16 Campsite D Bridge

Ohio Power Campsite 'D' over Brannon's Fork
Built: 1925
Length 41'

17 County Fairgrounds Bridge

Located at Morgan County Fairgrounds on State Route 376 just south of McConnelsville
Moved 1953
Length 58'

18 Island Run Bridge

Township Rd 269 over Island Run, Deerfield Twp Section 2
Built: 1867
Length 74'

19 Barkhurst Mill Bridge

Township Rd 21 over Wolf Creek, Marion Twp Section 4
Built: 1872
Length 81'
